2010 Bainbridge Island Home and Garden Show

WHAT: An all-day trade show, with accompanying workshops and demonstrations featuring displays from Bainbridge Island and Kitsap County area hardware, lumber and paint stores, architects and interior designers, contractors and builders, real estate agencies, nurseries, landscapers and other firms involved in the home and garden marketplace.

THEME: The theme of this year's Expo is "*Sustainable Living on Bainbridge Island.*"

WHERE: Woodward Middle School Commons and Auditorium, 10 a.m. to 5 p.m.
Saturday March 6, 2010.

AUDIENCE: The show is aimed at attracting locals and area residents interested in new home development ideas, home improvement projects, home decorating, landscaping and gardening, etc. Admission to the public will be free. Last year's event attracted more than 1,200 people.

FORMAT: Participating companies, organizations and individuals will be provided with 10' x 10' spaces on the auditorium floor. Exhibitors are responsible for their own booths, displays, etc. A limited number of 10' tables and chairs are available for Exhibitor use.

COST: Local and area companies: **\$250** for each 10x10 trade show booth. Non-Profit organization rate **\$150**. Bainbridge Island Chamber of Commerce members will receive a 20% discount. Discount deadline: Friday Feb. 26. Booth fees include 10 complimentary tickets.

GOAL: Provide area companies involved in the building trades and gardening with an opportunity to expose their products, services, knowledge and experience to the community at-large in a one forum/marketplace.
